

How I fish Lazy Larry's Beads

Take your line and tie on a #6, 8 or 10 hook, if using our Lazy Larry's hooks we advise fisherman to Snell the hook, this allows for more hook-ups when the fish takes the EZ bead. After tying on the hook of your choice take the Lazy Larry's EZ bead place it over the line about 2" above the hook and peg it in place with any kind of a rubber peg or a toothpick, I like to peg the bead in place with a Lazy Larry's peg from the bottom of the bead. The reason that we keep the bead at about 2" above the hook is so that when the fish goes for the bead the hook is naturally forced at the fishes mouth when you set the hook, this keeps the hook from being swallowed by the fish which makes for an easier and less traumatic release of the fish.

I haven't used beads for salmon fishing as of yet so I can't speak if salmon will take the bead, this may work when the fish are just entering the river system but I would reserve the use of the bead for either steelhead, brown trout or rainbow trout. These fish are entering the river system with and behind the salmon so that they can gorge themselves on the eggs that the salmon will ultimately be

dropping into their beds. I advise using the bead under a float and setting the distance of the float from the hook by judging the depth of the water that I am fishing so that the bead rides along the current just off the bottom of the water, this set-up is the most natural way to drift an egg (bead) and if the float moves from side to side or goes under pull back and hold on!!! You will get a tremendous rush of adrenaline and become just as crazy about bead fishing as Larry, Mark and I are!!!
